Lecture 2:

Cancer Screening Guidelines After Childhood Cancer (Dr Matthew Ehrhardt)

Advancements in treatment and supportive care have led to improved survival rates for children diagnosed with cancer. With extended survival has come the recognition of an increased risk of late occurring adverse health conditions, among which are subsequent neoplasms. Subsequent neoplasms represent a significant cause of morbidity and mortality in childhood cancer survivors. As such, there is a critical need for provider awareness of risk, implementation of surveillance programs, and patient education in order to mitigate these health risks for survivors.
