## Programme Synopsis

### Lecture 1:

#### Functional and Social Outcomes After Childhood Cancer (Dr Tara Brinkman)

This presentation will review social outcomes for adolescent and adult survivors of childhood cancer. In addition, social and functional independence in adult survivors will be described, including risk factors and consequences of failure to attain independence. The impact of disease, treatment exposures, and late chronic health conditions on social and functional outcomes will be reviewed. Future directions, including potential interventions will be discussed.

### Lecture 2:

#### Rehabilitation Across the Cancer Care Continuum (Dr Kirsten Ness)

This presentation will outline rehabilitation interventions designed to prevent or remediate functional loss for children with cancer, for children after cancer therapy and for adult survivors of childhood cancer. The impact of treatment exposures on physical function will be reviewed, and interventions designed to address specific impairments, including neuropathy, muscle weakness, low bone density, poor balance, amputation, limited mobility and suboptimal Kirstencardiopulmonary fitness will be described.
